DEPARTURES : 22 July, 29 July, 05 August, 12 August 2015

Day 01: BALIKPAPAN (D)

Upon arrival at Balikpapan airport, meeting service and transfer to Hotel, free at own leisure, evening dinner at Hotel

Day 02: BALIKPAPAN, SAMARINDA, MAHAKAM (LD)

Breakfast at Hotel, 10am transfer to Loa Janan, to board houseboat for exciting adventure on Mahakam river. Meals provided and overnight on houseboat.



Day 02: MUARA MUNTAI, MANCONG, TANJUNG ISUY, TENGGARONG (BLD)



Short sight seeing at Muara Muntai Wooden village, then crossing Jempang Lake by motor canoe to Mancong. During the cruise you could see Rain forest and wildlife at Ohong creek like monkey's and birds, Upon arrival at Mancong, welcomed with a traditional ceremony by the Dayaq Benuaq, one of the Oldest Dayak Longhouse of East Kalimantan can be found here, Late afternoon by motor canoe to Tanjung Isuy for sightseeing and continue to Houseboat for dinner and overnight. Houseboat will cruise downstream to Tenggarong.

Day 03: TENGGARONG, BALIKPAPAN (B)

Arrive at Tenggarong, visiting the former palace of Sultan Kutai Kertanegara. Where you will see the Sultan's impressive collection of heirlooms, ceramics, Dayak's art and culture items, until departure transfer to Balikpapan airport for your onward flight to your next destination.

Mahakam River Cruise

Mahakam River is a highway of East Kalimantan Province, which can be reached via the main airport Balikpapan, or the local airport Samarinda. The River is almost 1.000km long, and the only way to bring you into the deep interior of East Kalimantan. The main attraction of the lower part are the Lakes, The art full Dayak Culture and Longhouses, the area is covered by mangrove, swamp, and lowland rain forest. The Tourism spots are the Villages and river life. The further you get upstream the more adventures it will be, till you reach the dense jungle after the rapids.

Mahakam River Weather

Day Temperatures 27 °– 32°C

Night Temperatures 20 °– 25°C

Humidity 80%-90%

Rainfall 4,000mm per year

Wet Months October & June

Dry Months February & August (but expect daily rain)



Mahakam River Accommodation

Mahakam River has poor accommodation facilities at the villages, The houseboat has 10 air-condition Cabins with each 2 beds, 4 hot and cold water showers on board, a Kitchen and relax rooms and terraces at the second floor in front and in the back which will cruise you slowly through the hinterland, enjoying the scenery along the river sliding away

Balikpapan Sepinggan international airport with direct Flights to Jakarta, Surabaya, Semarang, Tarakan, Berau, Palu, Makassar, Manado, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Kota Kinabalu

Samarinda Airport with direct flights to Melak, Balikpapan, Berau, Tarakan, Nunukan, Long Apung, Tanjung Selor (ATR – Airvan planes)

The wildlife is exotic, lots of water birds, along with the endemic proboscis monkeys, and other forest denizens including clouded leopard, leaf monkey, macaque, pangolin anteater, tiny tarsier, lizards, and pythons. The Tribal Cultures on the way are more then 40 tribes, with all their own cultural believes and art, from longhouses, to earlobes and tattoo's

HOUSEBOAT

MAHAKAM RIVER CRUISE



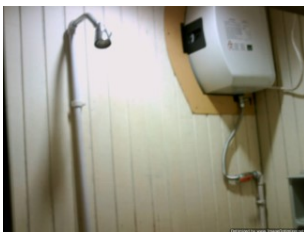
The Houseboat at the Mahakam River is an individual wooden cruise boat with a length of about 35 meters long, and almost 6 meters width. Upon the size, the houseboat can accommodate up to 24 passengers, at private cabins.



The Houseboat has 2 floors, the first floor is for the cabins (10-12 cabins) with air-conditioning for each cabin, in the back you can find a kitchen with 4 private Toilet and shower facilities (hot and cold water)



The second floor, has an air-conditioned dining and relax room, and in the back and front private terrace for view during your cruise



The Houseboat crew are 5 persons, the captain, a second captain, and a helper, and also a private cook and a helper, which can serve you the meals as your wish
